## HARBORSIDE FOUNTAIN PARK

Walker Macy designed the city of Bemerston's first ever public waterfront, finally linking the community to both its history and to Puget Sound, while providing a critically needed recreational space. The park resolves several complex issues, such as how to balance public elements with restrictive adjacent uses, and how to create a place which could rejuvenate civic pride in an economically depressed area. Fountains, plantings, and sculptures provide interactive play and wading areas, and moveable seating and picnic tables encourage public engagement with the space. This multi-use recreational space, though small in size, has proven to be a large factor in the community's efforts to redefine itself.
